

THE RECTOR

HAVING REGARD TO Rector's Decree, protocol no. 0142087 of 18/03/2026, by which the call for applications for admission to the XLII cycle of PhD Programmes with administrative offices at the University of Milano-Bicocca was issued;

HAVING REGARD TO Article 2 of the aforementioned decree, which provides for Session II of the selection procedure, dedicated to positions activated in collaboration with companies, with applications open from 1 July to 22 July 2026;

CONSIDERED that additional funds have been made available by companies and external bodies to finance PhD scholarships for the XLII cycle of PhD Programmes, and that specific agreements have been entered into with such bodies;

HAVING REGARD TO the fact that, following approval of the documents relating to the outcomes of Session I of this call, certain PhD scholarships funded through University funds, including scholarships reserved for foreign candidates residing abroad, Department funds, and funds from external bodies, were not assigned, and are therefore offered again in the present session;

CONSIDERED that the PhD Programmes in "Resources for the new p.a.: people and data" and in "Nursing and Midwifery" will be included exclusively in the second session of the call, with the application opening date indicated above;

CONSIDERED that an additional decree may be issued to increase the total number of positions offered under the call, which will be published before the deadline of the call;

GIVEN THAT the proposing Head certifies the regularity and legality of this measure;

HEREBY DECREES

Article 1

Publication of Session II positions

For the reasons set out in the preamble to this measure, which are hereby deemed to be fully incorporated herein, the "Description Sheets XLII cycle – Session II", attached to this Decree and indicating the positions offered, shall be published.

Article 2

Provisions of the Call

All provisions of the call for applications, Rector's Decree protocol no. 0142087 of 18/03/2026, shall be deemed referred to and valid, except for the matters specifically governed by this decree.

Article 3

Selection sessions

The increase in the number of PhD scholarships may result in an increase in the total number of positions offered under the call. Such additional positions will be announced by a subsequent decree, forming an integral part of the call, which will be published by the deadline of Session II on the webpage: <https://en.unimib.it/study/doctoral-research-phd-programmes/applying-doctorate>

Article 4

Project/topic positions and scholarships, higher education apprenticeship contracts, and reserved positions

Note: *In the event of any inconsistency or discrepancy between the English and Italian versions of this Call, the Italian version shall prevail.*

For certain PhD Programmes, as indicated in the attached description sheets, scholarships are reserved for foreign candidates residing abroad. In order to compete for such scholarships, candidates must attach to their application for admission, in addition to an identity document, an official document certifying residence abroad, namely a residence certificate issued no more than six months earlier by foreign local authorities, such as, by way of example, a Municipality, Police authority, Police Headquarters, Registry Office, or Ministries.

Article 5

Fees and contributions

The amount of the contributions required for admission to and attendance of PhD Programmes is approved annually by the Board of Directors.

For academic year 2026/2027, all PhD students are required, upon enrolment, to pay the amount of €146.00, as specified below:

- stamp duty: €16.00
- advance payment of the regional tax for the right to university study: €130.00

The second instalment is due by 14 May 2027 and consists of the balance of the regional tax and the university contribution. The balance of the regional tax is due by PhD students, both scholarship holders and non-scholarship holders, on the basis of their ISEE, according to the following scheme:

- for ISEE lower than or equal to €26,887.93: €0.00;
- for ISEE between €26,887.93 and €53,775.86: €30.00;
- for ISEE higher than €53,775.86 or in the absence of an ISEE: €60.00.

The university contribution is due only by PhD students who hold a scholarship. The maximum contribution applicable to each PhD student is €1,200.00 and is due for ISEE values above €48,200.00 and by PhD students who do not submit the ISEE within the deadlines set by the University.

The university contribution due by PhD students holding a scholarship is calculated in the same way as that due by deserving students enrolled in study programmes falling within contribution area A.
