HAVING REGARD TO the Statute of the University of Milano-Bicocca issued by Rectoral Decree no. 0010332/15 of 3 March 2015;

HAVING REGARD TO - Legislative Decree no. 125 of 7 October 2020, on "Urgent measures connected with the extension of the declaration of the epidemiological state of emergency due to COVID-19 and for the operational continuity of the COVID alert system, as well as for the implementation of Directive (EU) 2020/739 of 3 June 2020";

- the Prime Ministerial Decree of 7 September 2020, on "Further provisions to implement Legislative Decree no. 19 of 25 March 2020, on urgent measures to deal with the epidemiological emergency due to COVID-19, and Legislative Decree no. 33 of 16 May 2020, on further urgent measures to deal with the epidemiological emergency due to COVID-19";

- the Prime Ministerial Decree of 24 October 2020, on Further provisions to implement Legislative Decree no. 19 of 25 March 2020, changed, with amendments, from law no. 35 of 25 May 2020, on "Urgent measures to deal with the epidemiological emergency due to COVID-19", and Legislative Decree no. 33 of 16 May 2020, changed, with amendments, from law no. 74 of 14 July 2020, on "Further urgent measures to deal with the epidemiological emergency due to COVID-19";

- the Prime Ministerial Decree of 3 November 2020, which introduces further urgent measures to contain the contagion in Italy and in particular Article 3 letter g) in the part in which it states: *"attendance of educational and curricular activities at universities is suspended... omissis..., without prejudice to the continuation of such activities at a distance; courses for doctors undergoing specialised training, specific training courses in general medicine, as well as the activities of trainees in the health professions and other didactic or curricular activities that may be identified by the universities, after consulting the relevant regional University Committee, may also continue, where necessary, with in-person attendance...omissis..."*

DECREE

ART. 1

The following educational provisions have been issued following the Prime Ministerial Decree of 3 November 2020.

Art. 1 DEGREE SESSIONS

- In the master's degree and single-cycle degree sessions all graduands will be remotely connected.
- The Degree Committees will preferably meet in person and in any case at least one commissioner must be present at the University.
- For all remotely connected graduands and commissioners the connection tests will be reinstated as in the first lockdown.
- The current remote methods will continue to be used for the three-year degree sessions.

Art. 2 - LESSONS AND STUDY SPACES

- Teaching activities (lessons) previously planned in person (especially for first-year students) are suspended. These activities will only be provided remotely in the manner (synchronous, asynchronous, mixed) deemed most appropriate.
In this regard, synchronous sessions are again recommended in all asynchronous teaching activities.
- The study spaces will not be usable.

Art. 3 - EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS AND FIELD EXPERIENCES

- In-person activities already planned for the educational workshops and field experiences are confirmed, without prejudice to the possibility of exempting students who, due to an objective impediment, cannot participate.

Art. 4 - DISABLED SERVICE AND DSAS

- For students attending educational workshops, support from the Disability Service and DSAs remain active as agreed with the service. For other students, the support activities of the Disability Service and DSAs will continue remotely.

Art. 5 DISSERTATIONS

- Where deemed necessary, students involved in activities related to the completion of their dissertation are permitted to attend research labs.

Art. 6 - CURRICULAR INTERNSHIPS AND TRAINEESHIPS

- In-person curricular internships and traineeships at the university are suspended and activities will be carried out remotely where possible.
- Internships and traineeships conducted outside the University are possible in the manner agreed with the host institution.

Art. 7 - INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY

- International incoming and outgoing student mobility is suspended.

Art. 8 - MASTER'S AND GRADUATE TRAINING COURSES

- Master's lessons are provided remotely with the exception of laboratory activities, which may be carried out in person subject to prior agreement with the Master's Office.
- Procedures for the continuation of ongoing traineeships must be agreed with the Master's Office.
- Exams will only be held remotely.

Art. 9 - LIBRARY

- The loan and return service remains active, with the previously established procedures, upon reservation. For updates, please consult the website: <https://www.biblio.unimib.it/>
- The library consultation service is suspended.

Art. 10 - PHD STUDENTS AND RESEARCH ASSISTANTS

- PhD students and research assistants can carry out activities in person.
- If activities are planned, they may be carried out by external bodies in the manner agreed upon with the host institutions and after signing the "host institution form" provided by the Doctoral School.
- The teaching activities of PhD students are mainly provided remotely.

The provisions of this Decree shall remain in force from 6 November to 20 November 2020 unless new and different national and regional provisions are introduced.
