Prof. Franca Morazzoni, PhD in Chemistry at the University of Milano, became Associated Professor and then Full Professor of Inorganic Chemistry at the University of Milano-Bicocca. She funded the group of hybrid nanomaterials at the Department of Material Science in 2001. As an expert of physical methods in inorganic chemistry applied to hybrid materials, she published more than 250 paper in international journals. She was responsible of several national research projects in the field, participated to the development of inorganic nanofillers with controlled shape, to be included in tires, in collaboration with Pirelli Tyre. Several patents were signed on this topic. She was vice chair of the HINT COST action (2012-2016) on the organic-inorganic hybrid interface. Prof. Morazzoni has supervised several PhD students and until 2015 was director of the PhD School of the University of Milano-Bicocca. She plays piano giving regularly performance.
