Background

Elisabetta Ruspini is an Italian Sociologist, senior Associate Professor of Sociology at the University of Milano-Bicocca, Italy. She holds a PhD in Sociology and Social Research from the University of Trento (1997). Her thesis “Women and Poverty: The Case of Germany and Great Britain” was based on longitudinal data from the German Socio-Economic Panel (GSOEP) and the British Household Panel Survey (BHPS)

In 2013 she was declared suitable (ASN-Abilitazione Scientifica Nazionale/National Scientific Qualification) to work as full Professor in Italian Universities (General Sociology). In 2017 she was awarded a second ASN-Abilitazione Scientifica Nazionale/National Scientific Qualification for a full Professorship in Cultural Sociology. She has published a relevant number of books (authored books and edited books/journal issues), articles and contributed papers to several national and international conferences/seminars/workshops in these fields.
